- 2. Increase ratio of nursing qualified staff and train frontline staff in infection control & provide time for them to use these skills
- 3. Allow residents to use outdoor spaces during lockdowns
- 4. Support & provide time for dementia-trained staff to use skills
- 5. Support the development & wellbeing of staff as well as the wellbeing of residents/clients
